A1	4	Polka in, out Around 2,3, around 2,3	Ballroom hold: 1 polka step in, 1 out 2 turning polka steps to move one place to R around set, whilst turning cw 3/4
A1&2	12	Repeat 3x	To return to place
B1	8	Grand star R & L	In W-Sh hold. Rh people (Rbs) make Rh star, then wheel to put Lh people (Lks) in centre and star back to place.
B2	8	Circle L & R	Slide out to holding nearer hands. Use slip steps.
C1	8	1s arch over others	Cw around set. All set to ptnr if time.
C2	8	Balance and swing ptnr	Swing in ballroom hold
		Repeat	Next time, 2s arch etc.
